**WHAT IS EARLY VOTING?** The first thing voters need to know is you don’t need an excuse to vote early. Voters from any precinct in the County may come to the Cumberland County Annex to vote early. In early voting, you may vote at the County Annex instead of your regular precinct. The process allows all registered voters to cast their ballot prior to Election Day. Early voters must be registered voters prepared to present a valid picture ID showing their current voter registration address.

**WHAT IS GRACE PERIOD VOTING?** Any Cumberland County resident that is eligible to vote and hasn’t previously registered, may come to the Cumberland County Clerk’s office to register and vote the same day. Residents should bring two forms of identification that includes their current address. Grace Period Registration & voting will be conducted beginning March 8- April 4, 2017

Early cast votes and grace period votes are tabulated at the Cumberland County Clerk’s office on Election Day.
