

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Cumberland County will hold a public hearing on July 14, 2020, at 6:30 pm, in the Board Room at the Annex to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed Downstate Small Business Stabilization application funded by Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. On or about July 15, 2020, Cumberland County intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used to provide working capital for the benefit of Long Point Creek Antiques. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$25,000.00 and will address the urgent needs of the business due to the COVID-19 emergency.
